4th of July Closure

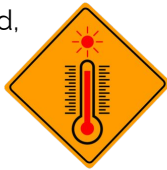
IXL Learning Center will be closed on **Friday, July 4th** for Independence Day. If you know your child will be absent around this date, please fill out a Parent Request form. You can find the link for this on your center's page under "IXL Quick Links."

Reminder that IXL requires full tuition payment for the days we are closed. You may use your vacation credit for the closed days, with a two week's notice, if you have any remaining for the year.



Extreme Heat Conditions

When extreme heat conditions are forecasted, directors/admin will utilize the National Weather Service to review the daily heat index, UV index and air quality, to determine if conditions are appropriate for outdoor play and activities.



- During any heat advisories or warnings, children and teachers will only go outdoors if these factors are not at dangerous levels.
- If directors determine that it is safe for children to play outdoors, teachers will do the following to keep kids cool:
 - Have **drinking water** available for children at all times
 - Remind children to take **frequent breaks** in a **shady area**
 - **Limit outdoor time** to no more than 10-15 minutes at a time (rotate indoor/outdoor times, allowing cool down)
 - Limit high energy activities

Classrooms will try to get outdoors as early in the morning as possible before the heat, as long as conditions are safe. Outdoor field trips may be switched to indoors during extreme heat advisories or warnings.

IXL Teachers have been made aware of best practices during extreme heat conditions.

Summer Reminders

Summer Attire/Shoes:

- Please dress your child appropriately for the warmer weather and have extra summer clothing available in your child's cubby in case of accidents/spills.
- We recommend children wear closed toed shoes for the playground. Older infants/toddlers need outdoor shoes as well.
- All infants will enjoy outdoor time, including stroller rides if they are not old enough for the playground. Please remember to bring a sun hat each day for your infant.
- A sun hat or baseball cap is always helpful to keep the sun away for all children while playing outside. If you choose to bring one for your child, please remember to label it. Your child will wear it outside, along with sunscreen.

Sunscreen/Bug Spray:

- Please review the guidelines for Sunscreen/Bug Spray found in this [link](#).
- IXL highly recommends that all parents provide a bottle of sunscreen for their child. This must be NON-EXPIRED and LABELED with the child's FIRST and LAST name.
- Due to their proximity to wooded areas, IXL also recommends that parents who have children in our Livingston County locations provide a bottle of bug spray for their child. Again, this must be NON-EXPIRED & LABELED with the child's FIRST and LAST name.

Water Bottles:

- Please bring your child a labeled water bottle to use while playing outside.

Water Play Days:

- On your child's water play day, please remember to bring a bathing suit & towel. Sun hats, sun shirts and water shoes are also recommended. Please label all items with child's first and last name.

Field Trips:

- For children 4 years & older who are eligible for field trips, please remember to check the summer camp program guide for field trip bus times and any "needs" for the field trip that day. Children must arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the bus departure time and wear their IXL summer camp t-shirt for every field trip.

Parking Lot Safety:

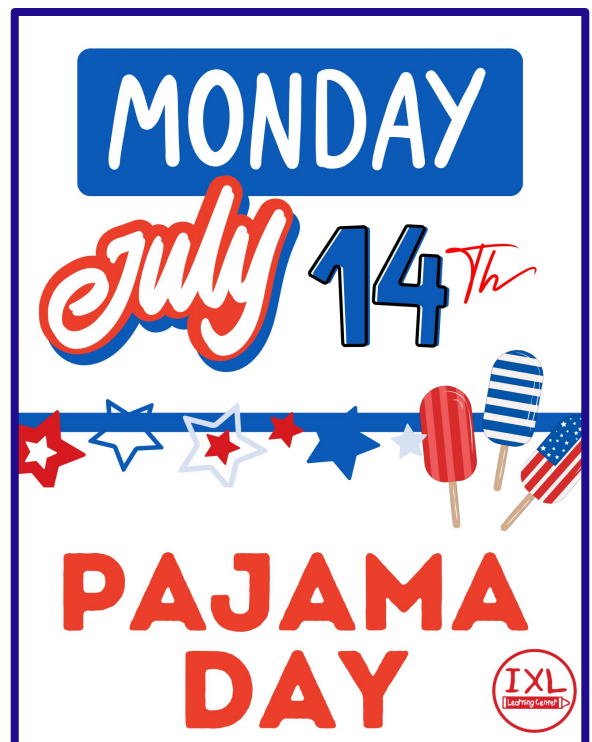
- Be sure to drive slowly through our parking lots, as children may be walking into or out of the building.
- Make sure to reserve handicapped spots for those that may need them.
- During pick up and drop off be sure to lock your car doors and keep valuables out of sight. This includes your purse, phones, laptops, etc. Rolling up windows is also a good idea!
- Please don't leave your kiddos in the car while you run inside to grab forgotten items or to pick up siblings.
- Even though we all want to be polite, please make sure to keep the door code private, as well as remember not to open doors for others unless you are certain they are IXL parents or staff.

Important Reminders:

- IXL Learning Center's hours are from 7am-6pm. Drop off is not permitted before 7am, and a late pick up fee will be applied to your account for any pick ups after 6pm. Any pick up between 6:01-6:10pm will be applied a \$10 fee and \$2/minute will be added for any pick up after 6:10pm.
- Tuition payments are due in full on or before 10:00am Friday for the following week of attendance.
- A reminder that smoking and vaping is prohibited on IXL property per the State of Michigan.

Requests in Scheduling

To make a scheduling request, follow the "IXL Quick Link" below or scan the QR code near the entrance to our building to make a request. This includes Add Day, Switch Day, Vacation or Absence and Drop In.

Please note that add or switch days are based on the availability of your child(ren)'s classroom(s). If you are making a permanent switch to your child's schedule, IXL requires a 2 week notice to look into availability and approval.

Absence/Vacation forms are due to the office 2 weeks prior to the date requested for billing purposes. Other request forms are appreciated as soon as possible, as this helps with verifying availability and ensuring the accuracy of your account balance.
