
March is Reading Month!

CREATING STRONG READERS:

Tips for Reading with Your Child at Home

- Invite a child to read with you every day.
- When reading a book where the print is large, point, word by word, as you read. This will help the child learn that reading goes from left to right.
- Read a child's favorite book over and over again.
- Read many stories with rhyming words and lines that repeat. Invite the child to join in on these parts. Point, word by word, as he or she reads along with
- Discuss new words. For example, "This big house is called a palace. Who do you think lives in a palace?"
- Stop and ask about the pictures and about what is happening in the story.
- Read from a variety of children's books, including fairy tales, songbooks, poems and information books.

READING TO INFANTS & TODDLERS:

Tips to Engage our Youngest Learners



CUDDLE UP

Cuddling with your infant or toddler as you read helps them feel safe, warm, and connected to you.

USE REPETITION

Infants and toddlers love — and learn from repetition, so don't be afraid of reading the same books over and over. When you do, repeat the same emphasis each time as you would with a familiar song.

READ WITH **EXPRESSION**

Make your voice higher and lower as you read or use different voices for different

characters.

STOP TO ASK QUESTIONS OR MAKE COMMENTS

Don't worry about following the text exactly. Stop once in a while to ask questions or make comments on the pictures or text. ("Where's the kitty? There he is! What a cute black kitty.") Your child might not be able to respond yet, but this lays the groundwork for doing so later.

MAKE READING FUN

Sing nursery rhymes, make funny animal sounds, dress like the character or bounce your child on your knee anything that shows that reading is fun.



LEARNING ABOUT BOOKS

As your baby gets older, encourage your little one to touch the book or hold sturdier vinyl, cloth, or board books. Infants & young toddlers like putting books in their mouth. They are learning about themfinding out how books feel (and sometimes taste).

If IXL deems it necessary for closure, delayed opening or closing early, families and staff will be informed in the following ways:



Summer Enrollment Status:


With summer around the corner. your child's enrollment status must be maintained through the summer to secure their fall spot.
