## Preparing & Bringing Food from Home

There are some circumstances where children bring food from home, Any food from home should require minimal teacher assistance and adhere to the following:

- Pre-made, ready-to-eat, Nut-Free and Allergy Aware
- Prepared or cut food to the appropriate shape, size and texture for your child's development
- Stored in a food storage container (lunch box) labeled with first/last name and date (can include an ice pack if needed)
- Require minimal assistance for reheating

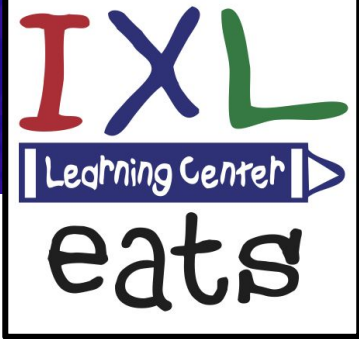

- All emergency contact information and phone numbers are accurate and up to date
- Voicemail box on your phone is not full

## Nannyng/Babysitting Policy

To avoid any conflict of interest, employees are prohibited from nannyng/babysitting children currently enrolled with IXL Learning Center. We politely ask that you refrain from inquiring with IXL staff in regards to such.

## Centerwide Reminders:

- Please continue to use slow speeds when entering and exiting the parking lot.
- Please do not give out the door code. We aim to keep it as just parents & primary pick up. It might seem rude, but please do not hold open the door for others you do not know. This is a parent/teacher touch only, please!
- When dropping off & picking up, children must remain with a parent at all time.
- Reminder that we are an Allergy Aware center. Please check labels on your child's food items brought into IXL.
- As the weather changes - please be sure to bring extra weather appropriate clothing in your child's bin.
