Child Paperwork Updates

We kindly ask that all families ensure their child's paperwork is updated as changes occur. This includes your child's placement contract, emergency contact, authorized pick up persons and health appraisals (signed by your child's physician).

There are certain permissions that Michigan state licensing requires to be updated annually. We have sent the link to these permissions via Tadpoles. If you haven't completed these permissions yet or would like to review/make changes to your child's paperwork on file, please stop by the office. Keeping your child's file current helps us provide the safest and most supportive environment possible.

Gearing Up for Summer Camp

Label, Label, Label!

Please remember that it is important to label all of your child's belongings. This includes all sippy cups, baby bottles, water bottles, clothing, bedding, etc. Please label each item with your child's first and last name. We always do our best to keep each child's belongings separate, however, things can get mixed up on occasion. Labeling all of your child's items each day is very helpful in reducing this. Please see the office if you have any questions.



Shoe Free Zones

Reminder that all of our infant classrooms are "Shoe Free Zones." When dropping off or picking up your little one, please remove your shoes to enter the shoe-free area in the classroom.

It's Sunscreen Time!

Now that the sun is shining, it's time to think about sunscreen! IXL highly recommends that children regularly use sunscreen during outdoor play in order to prevent sunburns. Please bring in a new bottle for each of your children - don't forget to check the expiration date and label it with your child's name! Also, if there are any special circumstances or instructions to apply your child's sunscreen, please make your child's teachers aware. IXL will apply sunscreen for AM and PM outdoor time.



Warmer Weather can also Bring Bugs



As the weather begins to get nicer, the bugs can sometimes be bothersome in our outdoor play areas. If you are interested in having your child wear bug spray throughout the spring/summer season, please bring in a LABELED bottle of bug spray. IXL will only apply bug spray to children with permission and who bring their own supply. Please check with the office to see if you signed off on this for your child.

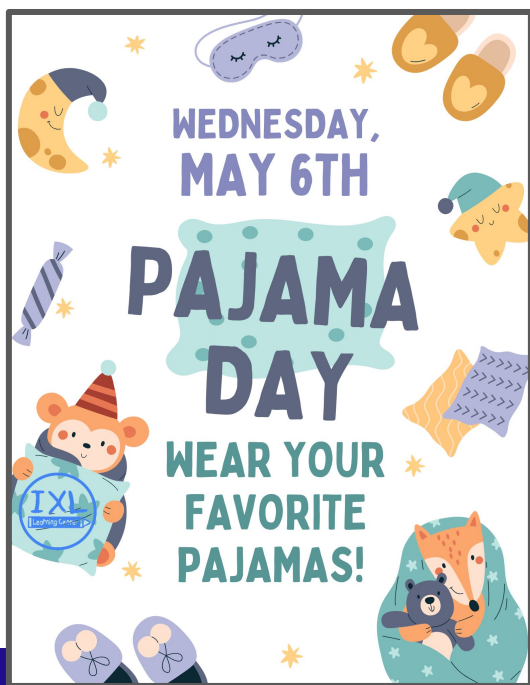
IXL Learning Center Save the Date: IXL Summer Spectacular

Important Reminders:

- IXL is an ALLERGY AWARE facility- this includes not bringing items to IXL that may contain peanuts or tree nuts. Check labels of food containers that you are sending to IXL with your child to ensure safety (ex: cereal, granola bars).
- A reminder that smoking and vaping is prohibited on IXL property per the State of Michigan.
- IXL Learning Center's hours are from 7am-6pm. Drop off is not permitted before 7am, and a late pick up fee will be applied to your account for any pick ups after 6pm. Any pick up between 6:01-6:10pm will be applied a \$50 fee and \$5/minute will be added for any pick up after 6:10pm.
- Closed-toe shoes are best for the playground and outdoor play to avoid tripping and hurt toes.
- Please make sure that you are sending in extra seasonally appropriate clothes for your child. Accidents happen and it is always safe to have some at IXL just in case!

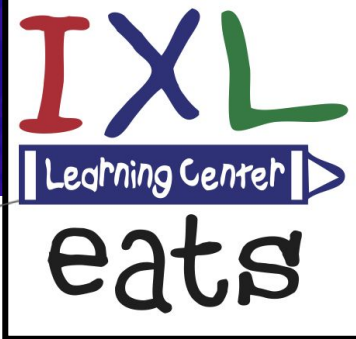

Preparing & Bringing Food from Home

Please review [Parent Info: Preparing Food From Home](#) for some information on preparing your child's food items that are brought from home.

There are some circumstances where children bring food from home. Any food from home should require minimal teacher assistance and adhere to the following:

- Pre-made, ready-to-eat, nut-free and allergy aware
- Prepare or cut up food to the appropriate shape, size and texture for your child's development
- Stored in a food storage container (lunch box) labeled with first/last name and date (can include an ice pack if needed)
- Require minimal assistance for reheating



Monthly Supplies

Please bring your labeled supplies to the office by the end of each month. Monthly supplies are per family.

2 ½ & Younger:

- 1 package of unscented baby wipes &
- 1 roll of paper towel

2 ½ & Older:

- 1 package of unscented baby wipes &
- 1 box of tissue

Classroom Corner:

- **Infant** - Please make sure to take home all bottles and items at the end of each day.

- **Toddler** - Please make sure to label all your child's belongings and take home water bottles at the end of each day.
- **Toddler Too/Preschool** - Please make sure to take home all food containers, water bottles and belongings at the end of each day.
- **Pre-K** - Please label all items brought from home with first and last name.
- **All Classrooms** - As the weather gets warmer, please be sure to bring in appropriate gear as we do go outside twice a day, weather permitting, per Michigan State Licensing. Michigan weather is always unpredictable during the spring season and the temps can vary vastly throughout the day.
